## **Estimated Average Costs**

It is important to note that the Tuition and Fees, Living Expenses and any other estimated average costs are **only estimates** based on an average student. The Tuition and Fees estimate is based on the "Most Majors" category. Iowa State utilizes a differential tuition model. Therefore, the exact tuition and fee amount that a student will be assessed will depend on the student's program of study. Detailed tuition and fee information related to a specific major can be found on the registrar's website.

The estimated average costs below are the estimated expenses that will appear on the student's I-20 or DS-2019.
