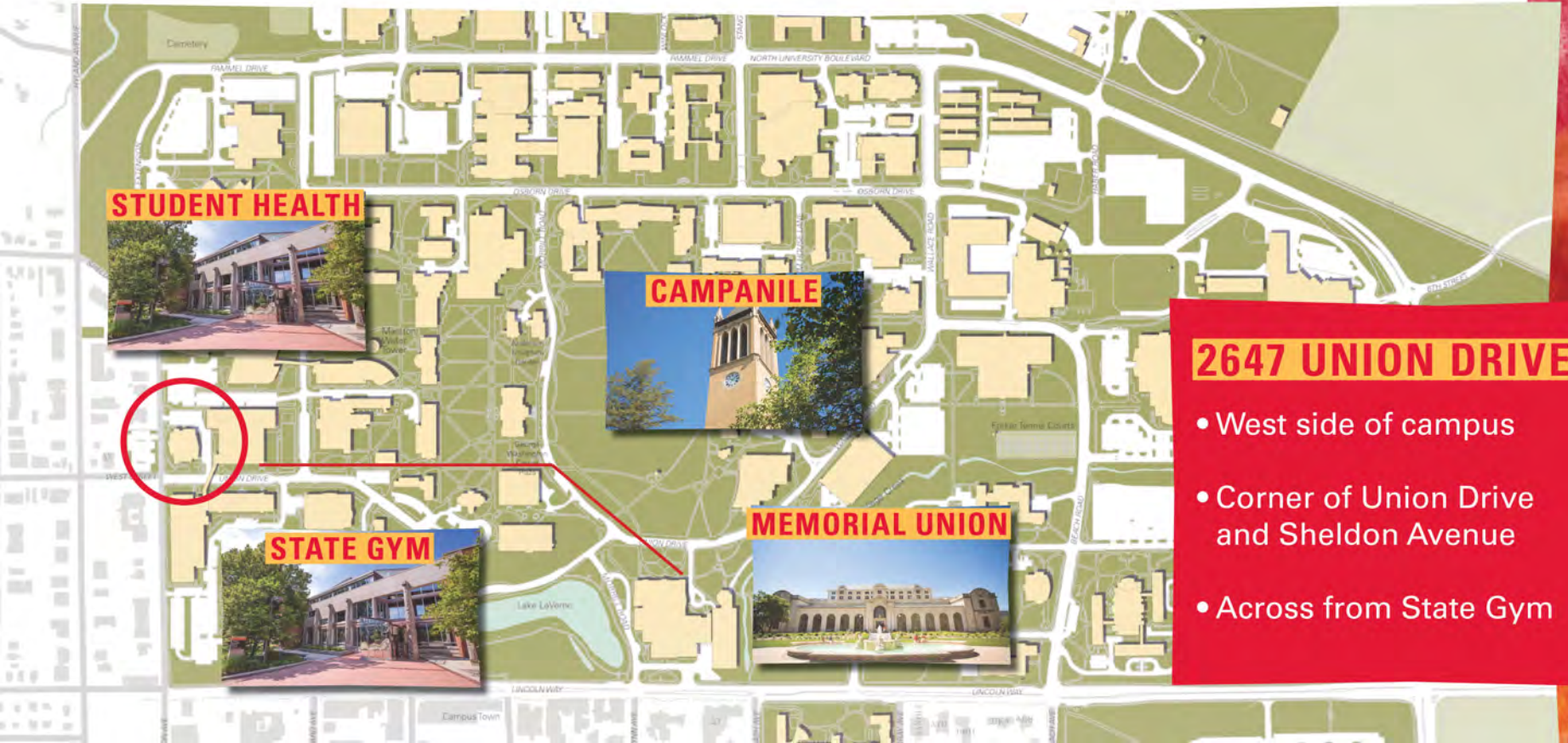

SELF-CARE CHECKLIST

Be prepared. Bring these items with you to campus in case you need to care for yourself.

Don't forget about the possibility that you may get sick at school. To ensure that you have a safe and healthy start at Iowa State, bring the following items along with you as a first-aid kit:

- Thermometer
- Bandages
- First-aid ointment
- Wraps for muscle strains or minor sprains
- Over-the-counter pain reliever and/or fever reducer, such as ibuprofen, acetaminophen or both
- Over-the-counter allergy product with antihistamine
- Over-the-counter cough medicine containing dextromethorphan
- Over-the-counter cold product with a decongestant
- Over-the-counter anti-diarrhea medication
- A list of medications you take regularly
- A list of known or suspected medication allergies
- Photocopy of health insurance card(s) and policy holder information (date of birth, name, address)

NOTICE OF PRIVACY PRACTICES FOR THIELEN STUDENT HEALTH CARE CENTER Effective Date: November 1, 2017

Your Rights, Your Information, Our Responsibilities.

This Notice describes how medical information about you may be used and disclosed and how you can get access to this information. For purposes of this Notice, "we" and "us" refers to Iowa State University's Thiele Student Health Center and their business associates. Please carefully review this Notice.

Purpose of this Privacy Notice. This Notice of Privacy Practices (Notice) describes how Thiele Student Health Center (TSHC) at may use and disclose your protected health information to conduct health care operations, assist with your treatment, initiate payment, and for other purposes that are permitted or required by the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). The Notice describes your rights to access and control of your protected health information. "Protected Health Information" (PHI) is information about you, including demographic information, that may identify you and that relates to your past, present or future physical or mental health condition and related health care services. Iowa State University reserves the right to make changes to this Notice.

Who Will Follow This Notice? TSHC and Iowa State University work together to provide you with comprehensive and coordinated health-related services. These privacy policies are followed by:

- Any health care professional who treats you and/or who is authorized to enter information into your medical record;
- All employees of TSHC;
- All authorized trainees, students or volunteers of TSHC;
- Any Business Associate of TSHC; and
- Departments, such as the University's Information Technology Services, Office of University Counsel, and Risk Management, and their employees who provide support to TSHC (these entities may have access to your PHI while providing that support).

Your Rights. When it comes to your health information, you have certain rights. This section summarizes your rights and our responsibilities with respect to those rights.

Get a copy of your health and claims records	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can ask us to see or get an electronic or paper copy of your medical record and other health information we have about you. Ask us how to do this.• We will provide a copy or a summary of your health information, usually within 30 days of your request. We may charge a reasonable, cost-based fee.
Ask us to correct health and claims records	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can ask us to correct health information about you that you think is incorrect or incomplete. Ask us how to do this.• We may say "no" to your request, but we'll tell you why in writing within 60 days.
Request confidential communications	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can ask us to contact you in a specific way (for example, home or office phone) or to send mail to a different address.• We will say "yes" to all reasonable requests.
Ask us to limit what we use or share	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can ask us not to use or share certain health information for treatment, payment, or our operations. We are not required to agree to your request, and we may say "no" if it would affect your care.• If you pay for a service or health care item out-of-pocket in full, you can ask us not to share that information for the purpose of payment or our operations with your health insurer. We will say "yes" unless a law requires us to share that information.
Get a list of those with whom we	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• You can ask for a list (accounting) of the times we have shared your health information for six years prior to the date you ask, with whom (if with, and why).

MEASLES, MUMPS, AND RUBELLA (MMR)

- Required: Copies of immunization record with proof of 2 measles vaccines

MENINGITIS

- Not required: Highly recommended by the CDC and the American College Health Association

TUBERCULOSIS (TB) SCREENING

- Required for international students and recommended for high-risk groups

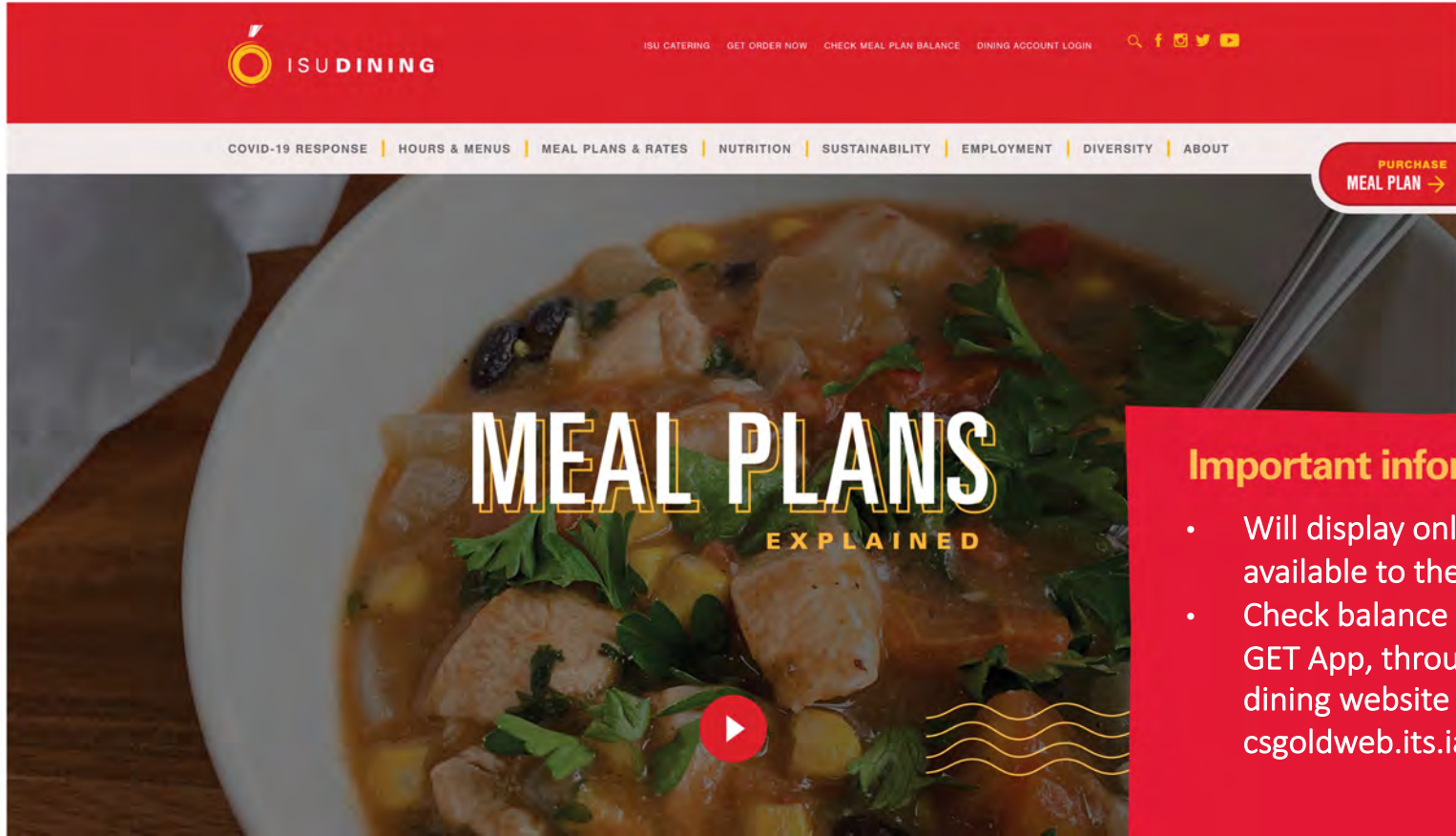

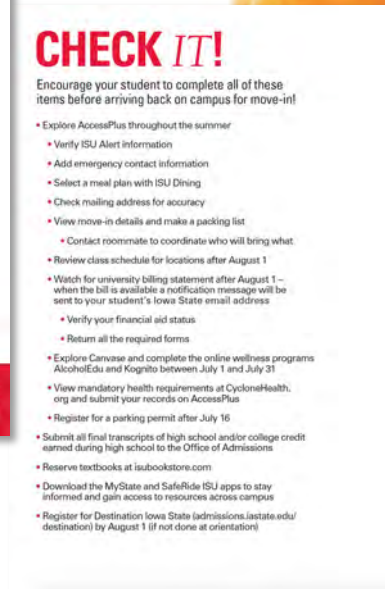
