- What information will we share through third party access on AccessPlus?
- What kind of meal plan do you think is going to be best for you?
- How will we prepare for move-in day? What will it be like to say goodbye?
- When you think about starting your first year at lowa State, what are you
 most excited about? Most nervous about? You might want to share with
 your student what excites you most too!

 - Watch for university billing statement after August 1 when the bill is available a notification message will be sent to your student's lowa State email address
 - Verify your financial aid status
 - Return all the required forms
 - View mandatory health requirements at cyclonehealth.iastate.edu and submit your records on AccessPlus
 - Register for a parking permit after July 22
- Select your ISU Dining meal plan at iastate.starrezhousing.com/ StarRezPortalX.
- Explore Canvas and complete the online wellness programs AlcoholEdu and Kognito between July 1 and July 31
- Submit all final transcripts of high school and/or college credit earned during high school to the Office of Admissions
- Reserve textbooks at isubookstore.com
- Download the MyState and SafeRide ISU apps to stay informed and gain access to resources across campus
- Register for Destination lowa State (admissions.iastate.edu/destination) by August 1
