## Admission Requirements for Students Educated in Bulgaria

**Please note: These are minimum requirements. The university reserves the right to enforce higher requirements as needed without notice to meet the university's enrollment needs.**

### Freshman Applicants

#### Minimum High School Course Preparation

- 4 years of applicant's native language
- 3 years of mathematics (including beginning algebra, geometry, and advanced algebra)
- 3 years of science (including one year each of two of the following: biology, chemistry or physics)
- 2 years of social studies [3 years for applicants to our College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS)]
- Applicants to majors in the LAS and Engineering colleges must have 2 years of a single foreign language (English may be used).

#### Minimum Academic Requirements

- Applicants must have a 5.0 cumulative grade point average (CGPA) in all academic subjects at the secondary level, and earn the *Diploma za Zavarsheno Sredno Obrazovanie/DZSO*. The following subjects are not included in CGPA: music, art, physical education, vocational/technical courses, or religious subjects

#### Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)

- The SAT is not *required* for admission to Iowa State for students educated in non-American patterned schools.

### Transfer Applicants

#### Minimum Academic Requirements

A minimum transfer cumulative grade point average of 3.75/6.00 in all transferable courses is required for engineering applicants; a 3.30/6.00 is the minimum for applicants to other majors.
