Admission Requirements for Students Educated in Denmark

Please note: These are minimum requirements. The university reserves the right to enforce higher requirements as needed without notice to meet the university's enrollment needs.

Freshman Applicants

Minimum High School Course Preparation

- 4 years of native language
- 3 years of mathematics (including beginning algebra, geometry and advanced algebra)
- 3 years of science (including one year each of two of the following: biology, chemistry, or physics)
- 2 years of social studies [3 years for applicants to our College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS)]
- Applicants to majors in the LAS and Engineering colleges must have 2 years of a single foreign language (English may be used).

Minimum Academic Requirements

- Applicants with *Studentereksamensbevis*: must have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of **7.0/13** in academic subjects on the *studentereksamen*. The following subjects are not included in CGPA: music, art, physical education, vocational subjects, or religion.
- Applicants with *International Baccalaureate Diploma*: Full IB diploma holders meet university CGPA requirements.
- Applicants with a full *Højere forberedelsesksamen/Hf*: will be considered on the basis of subjects taken and marks earned in individual examination subjects.

Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT)

- The SAT is not *required* for admission to Iowa State for students educated in non-American patterned schools.

Transfer Applicants

Minimum Academic Requirements

The minimum cumulative GPA requirement for admission to engineering is **7.0/13** in all transferable courses. For all other majors, it is **6.5/13**. For schools on a 5-point scale, a grade of **2.7** is required for engineering, and **2.3** for all other majors.
