Admission Requirements for Students from Poland

Please note: These are minimum requirements. The university reserves the right to enforce higher requirements as needed without notice to meet the university's enrollment needs.

Freshman Applicants

Minimum High School Course Preparation

- 4 years of native language
- 3 years of mathematics (including beginning algebra, geometry and advanced algebra)
- 3 years of science (including one year each of two of the following: biology, chemistry, or physics)
- 2 years of social studies [3 years for applicants to our College of Liberal Arts and Sciences (LAS)]
- Applicants to majors in the LAS and Engineering colleges must have 2 years of a single foreign language (English may be used).

Minimum Academic Requirements

- Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 4/6 in all academic subjects at the secondary level, and earn the *Swiadektwo Dojrzalosci* (Maturity Certificate). The following subjects are not included in CGPA: music, art, physical education, vocational/technical courses, or religious subjects

Scholastic Assessment Test 1 (SAT 1)

- The SAT is not *required* for admission to Iowa State for students educated in non-American patterned schools.

Transfer Applicants

Minimum Academic Requirements

- A minimum transfer cumulative grade point average of 3.75/5.00 in all transferable courses is required for engineering applicants; a 3.30/5.00 is the minimum for applicants to other majors.
